

Rotary Volunteers Certificate of Recognition

RI will provide a certificate of recognition suitable for presentation to an individual Rotarian or non-Rotarian who has provided volunteer service through Rotary Volunteers at the club, district or international level. This same certificate is also appropriate for presentation to a Rotary club that has demonstrated excellent participation in Rotary Volunteers. Such Rotary club participation might include organization of a community volunteer system, hosting of an international volunteer, or involvement in a district volunteer project.

RI will issue a recognition certificate at the request of a District Governor, or District Vocational Service Chair. Please note that the requester is required to provide the name to be lettered on the certificate, the date needed, to whom the certificate should be mailed, and a description of the participation in Rotary Volunteers by the individual or club for which the certificate is requested. There is no charge for this service.
